Le Voyageur

During the 1600s, Le Voyageurs were found in the woods from Nova Scotia to Minnesota guiding early explorers and traders through the US/Canadian border lands. The earlier Voyageurs traveled up to 50 kilometers a day by river canoe in the summer and through frozen woods trails in the winters. This Loppet (Norwegian for large gathering of people) celebrates the contribution these Voyageurs made to establishing winter travel routes in North America.

Participation is the goal of the Fort Kent Loppet. We have designed the course and distances to suit beginning tourers, and accomplished long distance skiers alike. You can come out and tour a relaxed 10K loop in a relay format with your friends, challenge yourself with the next step of the ZZ km Waska Korteloppet, or become a true Voyageur and ski the entire 40 km.

Technique

You are free to use any technique that works best for you to travel through the woods as efficiently as you can. A wide skating lane will be set on the left, and a classic track will be set on the right side for those more comfortable in a track.
